Game On!

Grade: K-2nd

Miss Brzozowski

Join in the fun as children learn how to play team games together. We will focus on small and large group games, inside and outside games, like ameba tag, corn hole, gaga ball, and horse. Children will run, throw, skip, kick and work on other large movement skills.

Arts & Crafts

Grade: K-2nd

Do you like to be creative? This might be the class for you. We will explore a variety of ways to create art and craft projects; drawing, painting, paper mache, stitchery, modeling clay, beadwork, etc. Projects will be based on student interest, so bring your imagination and creativity!

Music and Movement

Get ready to move and groove in this fun summer class! Students will practice identifying patterns, develop listening skills, and follow directions by playing instruments, dancing, singing, and more!

STEAM!

Grade: 3rd-5th

This class will focus on STEAM related activities (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math). Students will be presented with a variety of challenges where they will have to think, reason, and construct solutions to meet these challenges.

Games Galore!

Grade: 3rd - 5th

Fun with Food Grade: 3rd - 5th Mrs. Fishbaugher

Enjoy cooking and baking simple snacks? We will explore different items found in your kitchen, and start basic kitchen skills. Students will spend time learning to measure, reading recipes, and cooking and baking food.

Fiber Arts Grade: 3rd- 5th Mrs. Caves

This class offers students a creative, hands-on introduction to fiber arts, with a focus on crafting using materials such as yarn and beads. Students will learn about a variety of fiber art tools and materials, and explore beginning crochet techniques and/or more advanced fiber art projects.

Games Galore! Grade: K-2nd Ms. Delany

Book Cooks Grade: K - 2nd Mrs. Holland

We will be cooking up fun and easy food creations, while at the same time practicing simple math skills such as measuring and counting. Literature and art will also be brought into this class as every cooking activity revolves around a special story or two.

Spectacular Science Grade: K-2nd Mrs. Caves

This is a hands-on class that will explore basic science concepts through fun, age-appropriate experiments. Students will investigate topics like chemistry, physics, and earth science while practicing skills such as observing, predicting, and following directions. The class encourages curiosity and discovery in a flexible, engaging environment.

Spanish

Grade: 3rd-5th

In this class, students will be introduced to basic vocabulary and their use in the Spanish language: alphabet, basic phrases, numbers, colors, classroom objects, animals, body parts, clothing, fruits and vegetables, and verbs. We will also explore the rich cultures and history of the countries that identify Spanish as a primary language.

Basketball Skills Grade: 3rd-5th

Mr. Bartol

This class is geared for those students beginning to learn the game of basketball. The class will focus on the basics of dribbling, passing, shooting, and team play. Students will use these skills while playing a variety of games. (Be sure to bring tennis shoes and a water bottle)

Stimulating Science Grade: 3rd-5th Miss Brzozowski

In this class, we will explore astronomy, life science, physics, and chemistry. Students will create, observe, discover, and have fun through discussions, videos, hands-on activities and more.

Additional Offerings

Beginning Band-Grade 4 (5th grade next year) Mrs. Fishbaugher

Current 4th grade students are eligible for the Beginning Band class, which is intended to expose your student prior to next year's 5th grade band class. Students will learn instrumental techniques, as well as instrument care and maintenance for their preselected instruments. These lessons will run in the afternoons during the days of summer school. **Schedule will be finalized once students register**

Instrumental Music -Grades 5th - 12th Mrs. Fishbaugher

Students will be scheduled for two lessons weekly. In order to give students small group lessons, a schedule will be created once the registration period has closed. If you would like a summer lesson time you must complete and return a summer school registration form. If you have a specific time request or if a certain day of the week works better than others, please let Mrs. Fishbaugher know so she can try to accommodate as much as possible.
